

**GOVERNOR GUINN MILLENNIUM SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM
CSN CO-ENROLLMENT FORM**

This form is used by Governor Guinn Millennium Scholarship students enrolled in a degree or certificate program at the **College of Southern Nevada (CSN)** to request to enroll with Millennium Scholarship support at another eligible institution. For complete information, please refer to the NSHE Governor Guinn Millennium Scholarship Policy and Procedures of the Board of Regents, Title 4, Chapter 18, Section 19.9.

The "HOME" institution (here: CSN) is the eligible college/university at which the student is enrolled in a program of study leading to a recognized degree or certificate. The "HOST" institution is any eligible institution where a student must be co-enrolled in coursework and the credits will be transferred back to the HOME institution. The HOME institution has the discretion to approve when and how co-enrollment will take place. Please refer to the procedures listed on CSN's Millennium Scholarship web-page for complete details.

If approved, I understand that I will be paid my Governor Guinn Millennium Scholarship by each institution for the credits taken at their campus at the appropriate per credit amount, up to a maximum of 12 credits combined.

- I must satisfactorily complete credits funded and approved on the Co-Enrollment Form.
- If I graduated from high school between 2001 and 2002, I must maintain a cumulative 2.0 semester grade point average. If I graduated in 2003 or after, I must maintain a 2.60 semester grade point average each semester during my first year of enrollment (first year is defined as less than 30 credit hours earned) or a 2.75 semester grade point average for each semester thereafter (beginning with the first semester in which 30 credit hours are earned) at both the Home and Host institutions.
- I understand that my eligibility status may not be correctly reflected on the Treasurer's website until the end of the semester when all records have been submitted and processed.
- Credits taken at another eligible institution must meet degree requirements at CSN. I must declare my major at CSN.
- Failure to meet the requirements of this agreement will result in my ineligibility for the scholarship. I must then follow the procedure for reinstatement.
- This is a binding agreement between the student, Home institution and Host Institution and may not be revoked once funds were disbursed at the HOST institution.
