Phishing is a type of scam tricking individuals into giving away sensitive information to criminals.

A cardholder was recently targeted in a phishing scam. The cardholder received a deceptive email from a person who posed as a college official requesting the purchase of gift cards. These fraudulent emails often closely resemble genuine CSN email addresses but may have slight variations. The impostor's goal was to obtain multiple gift cards.
