## III. Purdue Pegboard Dexterity Test

Each student will be allowed to practice each part twice. Third attempt will be the final score for each part. Totals of Part I & II will be added to overall points towards selection. Scores are valid for 5 years and students have two attempts at the Purdue Pegboard Dexterity Test. The highest scores obtained out of the two attempts will be used towards selection.

**IV. Health Care Experience** – Examples can include but are not limited to: CRCST, CNA, EMT, Medical Assistant, Pharmacy Tech, etc.

### > Completion of Central Sterile Technician Certificate from CSN or TMCC (4 points)

- Submit copy of certificate of completion with application packet to earn points.
- Note: If central sterile technician certificate was not awarded from an NSHE institution (CSN or TMCC), the student must contact the Program Director of Surgical Technology for approval, and points may be awarded for selection purposes.
- Earn Certified Registered Central Service Technician (CRCST) Credential (must be current at the time of application (8 Points)
  - Submit copy of certification proof with application packet to earn points
- > Credentialed Health Occupation other than CRCST (must be current at the time of application) (6 Points)
- > Paid Non-Clerical Healthcare Work Experience (must be six months within the last 2 years)
  - Documentation form completed by employer indicating work responsibilities and length of employment must be supplied. Clerical work will not meet this requirement. - > Volunteer Work in the Medical Field (must be within 12 months of the deadline)
  - Volunteer work can be related to anything in the medical field, must include patient interaction (clerical work will <u>not</u> meet this requirement), and must be at least 40 hours of service. The <u>Volunteer Work</u>

V. Letters of Recommendation – Students will be awarded 7.5 points by obtaining <u>one</u> letter of recommendation and 15 points by obtaining a <u>second</u> letter of recommendation:

- Points will <u>ONLY</u> be awarded if the letter is submitted correctly and has 6 of the 9 areas marked "good" or better. No points will be awarded if the letter is submitted incorrectly or has 5 or fewer areas marked "average" or better.
- Recommendation letters may be from a previous/current employer or where you completed volunteer work. Please be sure that the letter of recommendation is from someone in a supervisory role. All letters of recommendation must be current and within one year of the application deadline.
