

WHAT IS A MATH COREQUISITE COURSE?

Math corequisite courses are made up of two components that *must* be taken at the *same time*; one college-level component (12xE) and one remedial component (2x).

The 'x' in 12xE and 2x is in place of the 0, 4, or 6, depending on the course needed for a specific degree.

PREREQUISITE(S): NONE

Effective fall 2021 semester, all math corequisite courses will be open enrollment. This means students can enroll in these courses with no prior testing or course history.

WHICH COURSES ARE COREQUISITES?

There are three (3) math corequisite courses at CSN:

1. MATH 120E + MATH 20
2. MATH 124E + MATH 24
3. MATH 126E + MATH 26

MATH 120E + MATH 20

MAJOR: LIBERAL ARTS/
EDUCATION

MATH 120E with corequisite MATH 20 is equivalent to MATH 120 (Fundamentals of College Math). If a degree requires MATH 120, it will accept MATH 120E + MATH 20.

MATH 124E + MATH 24

MAJOR: BUSINESS

MATH 124E with corequisite MATH 24 is equivalent to MATH 124 (College Algebra). If a degree requires MATH 124, it will accept MATH 124E + MATH 24.

MATH 126E + MATH 26

MAJOR: STEM

MATH 126E with corequisite MATH 26 is equivalent to MATH 126 (Precalculus I). If a degree requires MATH 126, it will accept MATH 126E + MATH 26.

HOW TO REGISTER IN MYCSN

Complete a Class Search and add **both** MATH 12xE **and** MATH 2x **with the same four-digit section number** to the shopping cart. Then, complete enrollment normally.
