

Addressing Student Injury, Illness, or Exposure (On-Campus or Off-Campus at Clinical or Field Site)

- ❖ **ALL** injuries and incidents must be reported to the Environmental Health and Safety Department.
- ❖ Faculty or Staff aware of a student injury or exposure shall fill out an **Incident Report Form** and forward it to ehs@csn.edu.
- ❖ In case of student hospitalization or fatality, the student's faculty member or department shall notify EHS immediately.
- ❖ Proactively report all near-misses and safety or compliance concerns to EHS.
- ❖ Medical treatment is sought through the student's medical provider and is the financial responsibility of the student.

Life-Threatening Injury or Illness

- ❖ **On-Campus:**
Call University Police Services at **702-895-3669** or ext. **7911**
- ❖ **Off-Campus:**
Call **911** or go to the nearest **Emergency Room**



Non-Life-Threatening Injury or Illness

- ❖ Students with non-life-threatening injuries should refer to their medical provider for further evaluation and treatment.



Minor Injury Treatable with First Aid

- ❖ Obtain supplies from the nearest First Aid Kit.
- ❖ Students should refer to their medical provider for further evaluation, if necessary.



Exposure to Other's Blood/Body Fluids (During Clinical Activities)

- ❖ Student reports exposure to faculty or site supervisor.
- ❖ Faculty/department submits **Incident Report Form** and **Report of Exposure to Bloodborne Pathogens** to EHS.
- ❖ Student refers to their medical provider for further treatment.



Student Employee

- ❖ Student employees injured at work should follow the employee workplace injury process.
